## Christ Prep Graduation Requirements

Christ Preparatory Academy currently offers two diploma options: the traditional diploma and the distinguished diploma. The traditional diploma meets all the requirements of the Kansas State Board of Education and prepares a student for college. The distinguished diploma plan is designed to give the student a foundational biblical world view in which to prepare the student for entry into more competitive colleges. Students on this track will complete four years of the school's worldview course curriculum - an intensive study of philosophy, history, theology, government, art, music and economics.

## Traditional Diploma Requirements

Students must achieve a " $C$ " or better in the following courses in order to receive a traditional Christ Prep diploma.

## English (24 credit hours)

Grammar (or quiz-out by proficiency test)
(6) English 9
(6) American Literature and Composition
(6) British Literature and Composition
(6) English 12 or English Comp 1 and 2

## Math (18 credit hours taken in grades 9-12)

(6) Algebra 1
(6) Geometry
(6) Algebra 2

## Social Studies (18 credit hours)

(3) Geography
(6) US History
(3) Government

Elective from (3) Economics, (3) World History, or (6) Psychology

## Science ( 18 credit hours taken in grades 9 -12)

(6) Biology
(12) from among Physical Science (6), Chemistry (6), and Physics (6)

## Foreign Language ( 6 credit hours)

from among Spanish 1 (6), Latin 1(6), French 1 (6), or other available foreign language

## Computer (6 credits)

Computer Applications (6)

## Bible (12 credit hours)

from among Bible Survey/Christian Living (6), Starting Points (6), or Western Civilization (Worldviews) 1, 2, or 3.

## Fine or Performing Arts (6 credit hours)

from among Art Studio I, II, or III (6), Computer Graphics (6), Worship Choir or Band (4) or other approved courses

## Physical Education (6 credit hours)

Choose from football, cheer, cross country, volleyball, soccer, basketball, track \& field, golf, or other activities approved by the Academic Advisor. (Please note: a maximum 12 credit hours of athletics may be applied toward graduation requirements. All team participation credit will show as a Pass/Fail grade.)

## Electives (24 credit hours)

## Distinguished Diploma Requirements

Students must achieve a "C" or better in the following courses in order to receive a distinguished Christ Prep diploma.

English: Grammar (or quiz-out by proficiency test) and 18 credit hours from below
(6) English 9 and two of these:

American Lit/Comp (6), British Lit/Comp (6), English Composition I and II (6)

## Worldviews of Western Civilization (30 credit hours)

(6) Western Civilization 1
(12) Western Civilization 2
(12) Western Civilization 3

## Math (18-24 credit hours)

(6) Algebra 1 (*does not post to high school transcript if taken before $9^{\text {th }}$ grade)
(6) Geometry
(6) Algebra 2
(6) College Algebra/Trig

## Social Studies (9 credit hours)

(3) Geography and (6) US History

## Science (18 credit hours)

(6) Biology, and two courses from among Physical Science (6), Chemistry (6), and Physics (6).
*Note: Students who begin physical science in $8^{\text {th }}$ grade must take three additional science courses beginning in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade

## Foreign Language (12 credit hours)

(6) French 1 and (6) French 2 OR
(6) Spanish 1 and (6) Spanish 2 OR
(6) Latin 1 and (6) Latin 2

## Computer (6 credit hours)

Computer Applications (6) or equivalent
Fine or Performing Arts (6 credit hours)
Choose from among Art Studio (6), Computer Graphics (6), Yearbook (6), or Worship Choir/Band

## Physical Education ( 6 credit hours)

Choose from football, cheer, cross country, volleyball, soccer, basketball, track \& field, golf, or other activities approved by the Academic Advisor. (Please note: a maximum 12 credit hours of athletics may be applied toward graduation requirements. All team participation credit will show as a Pass/Fail grade.)

## Distinguished Diploma Electives (18 credit hours)

Choose at least 3 of these five courses: $4^{\text {th }}$ science class, $4^{\text {th }}$ English class, calculus, psychology (with dual credit level requirements), foreign language 3.
